Objective	The student will discover the rich history of the film industry.
Directions	Students will use the internet during and after class time to discover the history of film. Students are encouraged to take numerous approaches to this written assignment. For example, a student might opt to research the origins of film and moving pictures, the silent era, the beginning of talking pictures, the studio system, independent film making, and the history of numerous motion picture studios both past and present.

Students must include a reference section and cite ALL sources used. Papers are graded on quality not quantity; please provide as much information that is needed to cover your topic.
